

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting
Held Tuesday, February 15, 2022

At 7:31 pm Mayor Irons called the meeting to order. Councilmembers Scott Brown, Terry Nachtrab, Mike Bettinger, President Ryan Spangler, Nathan Gaubert, Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula and Village Attorney Paul Skaff were present. Roger Burditt was absent.

Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the minutes from the 2/1/22 council meeting as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mr. Spangler made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow Ordinance 1 & 2-2022 to be read by title only. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. After discussion by Mr. Skaff, the first reading of Ordinance No. 1-2022, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CUSTOMER SUPPLY AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF NATURAL GAS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was read by title only. Mr. Spangler made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow passage on the first and final reading as an emergency. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the first and final reading as an emergency. Mr. Gaubert seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

First reading of Ordinance No. 2-2022, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CUSTOMER SUPPLY AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF ELECTRICITY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was read by title only. Mr. Spangler made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow passage on the first and final reading as an emergency. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the first and final reading as an emergency. Mr. Gaubert seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

After review, Mr. Bettinger made a motion to approve payment of bills totaling \$75,169.61 as distributed by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.
