

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting
Held Tuesday, May 17, 2022

At 7:45 pm Mayor Irons called the meeting which was held at the Lodge at Strawberry Acres to order. Councilmembers Scott Brown, Mike Bettinger, President Ryan Spangler, Roger Burditt, Nathan Gaubert, Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula and Village Attorney Paul Skaff were present. Terry Nachtrab was absent.

Mr. Burditt made a motion to approve the minutes from the 5/3/22 council meeting as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mayor Irons reported that Tim Bock from Poggemeyer Design has had a chance to review all the Hall Street bids and supplemental information since the last council meeting. The two lowest bids were: Berman at \$181,467 and Helms at \$185,172. Based upon unfavorable findings regarding Bergman’s completion of projects within set schedules for other entities and the sensitive timing of the Hall Street project to be completed during the Springfield Schools summer break, Mr. Bock recommended that the Village accept the bid for Helms & Sons Excavating as the best bid. Mr. Bettinger agreed and made a motion to accept the Helms & Sons Excavating bid for the Hall Street project. Mr. Spangler seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. Mayor Irons stated that a meeting with the Hall Street residents will be scheduled, and the road will only be open to residents during construction.

Mr. Gaubert reviewed the quotes provided by our broker for the employee dental and optical insurance. A price comparison between our current provider, AlwaysCare, and an alternate company, Principal, shows that switching the optical and dental to Principal would save the Village approximately \$900 per year in premiums. Employees were polled regarding their dentists, and most will see no change. Mr. Gaubert made a motion to approve the one-year dental and optical quote from Principal effective 6/1/2022. Mr. Burditt seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mr. Brown reported that police sergeant Troy Major has resigned effective 6/4/2022 and thanked him for his years of service to the Village. Mayor Irons appointed Collin O’Connor as a police new hire as recommended by the Police Chief, with a one-year probationary period, with a start date pending completion of the required OP&F physical. Attorney Paul Skaff swore in officer O’Connor. Mr. Brown made a motion to confirm the mayor’s appointment. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mr. Spangler made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow Ordinance No. 9-2022 to be read by title only. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. First reading of Ordinance No. 9-2022, AN ORDINANCE SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ONEOHIO RECOVERY FOUNDATION REGION 4 BOARD, was read by title only. Mr. Spangler made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow passage on the first and final reading. Mr. Gaubert seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the first and final reading. Mr. Brown seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mayor Irons stated that the Strawberry Festival parade will be held on 6/19/22 starting at 1 pm at the municipal building. This year’s first Picture in the Park event will be held on Friday, June 3rd and will also be held the first Friday in July and August in Strawberry Acres Park.

After review, Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve payment of bills totaling \$112,299.95 as distributed by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.
