

VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 26 – 2022

AMENDING SECTION 105.16 OF THE HOLLAND CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is an Ohio Charter municipality with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3; and,

WHEREAS the Village of Holland has adopted Codified Ordinances governing wages and benefits of Village employees, and policies for the hiring of police officers and transfer of police officers from other law enforcement agencies to the Village, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend policies related to lateral transfers of police officers to the Village Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Holland, Lucas County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Holland Codified Ordinance section 105.16, Lateral Transfer For Full Time Police Officer, shall be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, incorporated herein. Section 105.16, as amended herein, shall be effective immediately upon passage hereof.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This measure is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents for the reason that the Village is experiencing police staffing shortages. The need to immediately retain certified law enforcement officers to protect the Village and its residents requires that the aforementioned policies are implemented immediately.
