

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting  
Held Tuesday, September 5, 2023

At 7:30 pm Mayor Lee Irons called the meeting to order. Councilmembers Justin Hoen, Mike Bettinger, Roger Burditt, Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula and Village Attorney Paul Skaff were present. Councilmembers Scott Brown, President Ryan Spangler and Nate Gaubert were absent. Mayor Irons announced that due to lack of a quorum no official business could take place at tonight's meeting. Topics tonight would be for informational purposes only.

Mr. Bettinger reported that the bid specifications for the purchase of a new dump truck are complete and they will be available and sent out for quotes.

Mr. Bettinger advised that a quote for crack sealing of multiple village roads will be presented to the Mayor for approval.

Mr. Burditt stated that the quote for a new swing set will be held over to the next meeting.

Mayor Irons advised that the contract for the engineering work for the Spectrum Drive project will be held over to the next meeting; gave a report for Scott Brown that multi-factor authentication will be implemented on the village computers; and that maintenance employee George Gibson retired on 9/1/23. The open maintenance position has been advertised for a new hire.

Mr. Burditt inquired on the status of the old barbershop being demolished. Mr. Irons advised the building is still waiting on inspectors.

Lt. Piotrowski reported that the new police vehicle is being upfitted and should be in service by October.

There being no further business able to be discussed, at 7:48 pm Mayor Irons adjourned the meeting.
