

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting
Held Tuesday, October 17, 2023

At 7:30 pm Mayor Lee Irons called the meeting to order. Councilmembers Justin Hoen, Mike Bettinger, President Ryan Spangler, Roger Burditt, Nate Gaubert, Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula and Village Attorney Paul Skaff were present. Councilmember Scott Brown was absent. Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the minutes from the 10/3/2023 council meeting as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Gaubert seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Based upon recommendation from Lt. Piotrowski, Mayor Irons appointed Todd Shelton as a police officer. Mr. Shelton is a former Holland PD employee with over 20 years of Holland service and is returning after serving at Waterville PD. After clarification that Mr. Shelton will be returning to the Village as an officer under our lateral transfer policy and pay rate starting at the “after 5 years” level, Mr. Spangler made a motion to confirm the Mayor’s appointment. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes. Officer Shelton will be sworn in by the Mayor later this week as he is currently out of town.

Mr. Spangler reviewed a quote from Perry Protech for the purchase of 3 Microsoft licenses and 4 ethernet adapters at a cost of \$2,673.08 to be used in conjunction with the server upgrades. Mr. Spangler made a motion to approve the purchase. Mr. Gaubert seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.

Mayor Irons updated council on items including the centennial Christmas tree lighting will be held at Strawberry Acres Park on December 2nd at 4 pm; the Halloween preschool “trunk or treat” event will be held on October 22nd from 1-3 for preschool age children; Republic trash collection today received numerous complaints for bad service – Mayor Irons will call Republic to discuss. The McCord Road roundabout lane lines are very faded, especially under the underpass – Mayor Irons will call Lucas County to discuss as a safety issue. The Kroger grand re-opening will be held at noon on October 25 for those councilpersons interested in attending.

Mr. Spangler gave updates on several Plan Commission issues including the Angola Road strip mall demolition due to a fire. Demolition is scheduled to begin on October 23rd. Jiffy Lube has abandoned its construction project on McCord Road; several letters regarding the property upkeep have been returned by the post office as undeliverable.

Mr. Bettinger made a motion to approve bills totaling \$935,760.67 for payment as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Hoen seconded the motion with roll call carrying five ayes.
