

VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 13-2024

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE LUCAS COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
DISTRICT'S SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is an Ohio Charter municipality with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Sections 3 and 7, including, but not limited to, establishing policies for the collection and disposition of solid waste and establishing on its own or participating with other communities to form a solid waste management district, and

WHEREAS, the Lucas County Solid Waste Management District (District) was established in 1989, and is in compliance with regulations and goals set by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3734 requires the District to develop a solid waste management plan that meets the regulations and goals of the OEPA, and

WHEREAS, the District has completed a draft Solid Waste Management Plan and submitted it to the OEPA on May 1, 2023. The OEPA has reviewed the proposed draft Solid Waste Management Plan and issued its non-binding advisory opinion concerning the proposal on June 15, 2023. The District amended the proposed plan according to the OEPA advisory opinion (Plan) and conducted a 30 day comment period from February 4, 2024 to March 5, 2024, and held a public hearing on March 5, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland has reviewed the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO,

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of Holland hereby approves the Lucas County Solid Waste Management District's Solid Waste Management Plan and authorizes the Mayor or the Village Administrator to execute any documents necessary to the implementation of the Plan.

Section 2. That the Village of Holland Clerk-Treasurer is directed to deliver to the District, attn: Julie Riley, 1011 Matzinger Road, Toledo, Ohio 43612, a copy of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
