

VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 2024

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN EMPLOYEE MOTOR VEHICLE POLICY AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is an Ohio Charter municipality in Lucas County with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to provide to the Chief of Police a Village-owned motor vehicle to be used by the Chief of Police outside ordinary business hours, on or off duty, including to be taken home, subject to terms and conditions of a motor vehicle policy agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Village of Holland hereby approves a Village of Holland Vehicle Policy Agreement, in substantially the same form as the attached, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Village of Holland Vehicle Policy Agreement and to modify the terms of the vehicle policy as an administrative function, as deemed necessary, without further directive of Council.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
