

VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 17-2024

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PROSECUTION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF
SYLVANIA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is an Ohio Charter municipality in Lucas County with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sylvania currently prosecutes criminal offenses occurring within the Village of Holland in the Sylvania Municipal court, however no contract for such services is in place at this time, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland has negotiated an Agreement for Prosecution Services with the City of Sylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Village of Holland hereby approves an Agreement for Prosecution Services, in substantially the same form as the attached, (Agreement), and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement and any other documents necessary to secure prosecution services.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 30-94 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this measure is an emergency measure, necessary to the immediate preservation of the health and safety of the Village and its residents, for the reason that criminal matters pending in the Sylvania Municipal Court require immediate attention and prosecution, and the Village is currently without a contract for such prosecution services.
