

VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 22-2024

APPROVING A NOAC ELECTRIC AGGREGATION CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH
PALMER ENERGY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is an Ohio Charter municipality in Lucas County with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, The Village has an opt-out electric aggregation and is participating in the Northwest Ohio Aggregation Coalition (NOAC) electricity aggregation program (“Program”), and

WHEREAS, the eligible residential and small businesses that have participated in the Program (“Participants”) since the Program’s inception in 2001 have collectively savings an estimated \$124 million, and

WHEREAS, the Program has advocated for residential and small business electric consumers in the Village at the regulatory matters before the PUCO. It also advocates at the Ohio House and Senate on legislation that would impact the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Village of Holland hereby approves An Electric Aggregation Coalition Consulting Agreement with Palmer Energy, in substantially the form attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
