

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting  
Held Tuesday, April 2, 2024

At 6 pm Mayor Ryan Spangler called the meeting to order. Council members Justin Hoen, Mike Bettinger, President Scott Brown, Sandra Hensley, Village Attorney Paul Skaff, Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula and Administrator Bob Bethel were in attendance. Sandy Almond and Nate Gaubert were absent / excused.

Ms. Hensley made a motion to approve the minutes from the 3/19/2024 council meeting as presented by the Clerk. Mr. Hoen seconded the motion with roll call carrying four ayes.

Mr. Brown made a motion to suspend regular rules of council to allow Ordinance No. 11-2024 to be read by title only. Mr. Bettinger seconded the motion with roll call carrying four ayes. First reading of Ordinance No. 11-2024, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RE-ENACTMENT OF CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 9 & 10-2024, was read by title only.

Police Sgt. Ed Marckel was in attendance and reviewed a monthly activity report for March.

Mr. Bethel stated that due to the solar eclipse on April 8<sup>th</sup>, traffic in the area may be heavier than normal. He also reviewed items on his activities report including this summer’s picture in the park planning and the Spectrum Drive road project preconstruction meeting.
