

**VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 24-2024**

MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been found that certain appropriation accounts for the 2024 fiscal year require additional revenues to allow for the proper procedures for the expenditure of monies to be followed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 21-2023, the permanent appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, shall be amended to provide for the following appropriations in the accounts and amounts as set forth below:

This represents total additional appropriations of \$7,600 in the General Fund; \$4,000 in the Street Fund; \$74,500 in the Capital Projects Fund; \$74,500 in the St Issue 2 Fund; and \$9,000 in the Park Capital Fund. The amounts set forth above as amended appropriations are in lieu of or in substitution for the amounts, if any, appropriated to these accounts by the permanent appropriation ordinance adopted for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, and the appropriations contained therein are repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that the above accounts must have sufficient balances for the proper expenditure procedures to be followed.
