VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 12-2025

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 113 OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND CODIFIED ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland is a charter municipality located in Lucas County, Ohio, with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, section 3, and

WHEREAS, in 1991 the Village of Holland Council adopted Ordinance 36-1991 establishing the Village of Holland, Ohio, Tree Commission, and codified the Ordinance at Chapter 113 of the Village of Holland Codified Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to repeal Chapter 113 of the Village of Holland Codified Ordinances, and to replace Chapter 113.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 113, Sections 113.01, 113.02, 113.03, and 113.04 of the Village of Holland Codified Ordinances, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That Chapter 113 of the Village of Holland Codified Ordinances is replaced as set forth in the attached Exhibit B, incorporated herein by reference

<u>SECTION 3.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
